BY-LAW NO. 2016-002

A By-Law to change the normal retirement age under the OMERS primary pension plan ("Primary Plan"), and the retirement compensation arrangement that provides benefits for members and former members of the Primary Plan ("RCA"), in respect of the employees identified herein.

Whereas the Regional Municipality of Halton Police Services Board ("Employer") previously enacted a resolution at their March 7, 1974 meeting and elected to participate in the Primary Plan and the RCA.

And whereas that resolution provides that the normal retirement age for the police officers (including cadets) identified therein shall be 65 years.

And whereas it is deemed desirable to change the normal retirement age from 65 years to 60 years for the police officers (including cadets) identified herein.

Therefore the Regional Municipality of Halton Police Services Board enacts as follows:

NRA 60 for Police

1. The normal retirement age of employees who are employed by the Employer as police officers as defined in section 2 of the *Police Services Act*, as amended from time to time, or as police cadets, and who are employed in staff or management positions, is 60 years.

This by-law is hereby enacted by the Regional Municipality of Halton Regional Police Services Board on the day of November, 2016.
