1. **Criminal Intelligence (pursuant to O. Reg. 3/99 and PSM Guideline No. LE-004)**

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Board that criminal intelligence shall be provided by the Service.
- 1.2 To support this policy, the Chief of Police shall:
- a) establish priorities and procedures for criminal intelligence, including strategic and tactical intelligence;
 - b) promote the use of criminal intelligence analysis by Supervisors to identify areas or issues requiring directed patrol, targeted enforcement, problem-oriented policing initiatives or community-based crime prevention initiatives; and
 - c) ensure that the Members have the knowledge, skills and abilities to perform the criminal intelligence function and the necessary tools and equipment.
